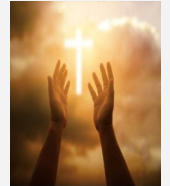

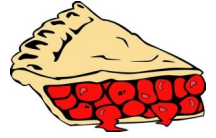

**Twenty-four members of the Henderson Work Camp Team are headed off June 22-26 to Frakes, KY to serve the Lord through helping the less fortunate people of Eastern Appalachia.** This will be our church's third mission trip to Henderson, and everyone is excited for this opportunity to work together as a team and represent First Pres.

Some will stay on campus working at the food pantry, thrift shop, greenhouse, or doing work on Henderson properties and grounds, while others will travel out into the community to repair a local resident's trailer home.

All team members are covering their own travel, room, and board for the 5-day mission trip. We have done some fund-raising for the \$2,000 total we need for the construction and renovation projects.
