Leaf Lanterns

- Supplies:
 - Tissue paper
 - Elmers Glue
 - Balloons
 - Paint brush
 - A container to place your lanterns in when drying.
 - Flameless tea light
 - Water
 - Leaves

Step 1:

Prepare your materials:

Search for fall leaves, inflate your balloon, cut tissue paper into squares and mix equal parts Elmers glue with equal parts water

Step 2:

For the first layer of covering, use plain water without glue. Dip the tissue paper right in the water and start a single layer on your balloon.

Step 3:

Add another layer of tissue paper, but this time add the glue mixture on top of the first layer of tissue. You can start to add leaves after you have your second complete layer of tissue paper on your balloon. Step 4: Add 1 final layer of tissue paper with glue mixture to ensure the leaves stay in place (you will have 3 layers total) Step 5: Let them dry. Step 6: Pop the balloons and add your flameless candle!
