Attendance is important! Please make sure your dancer is attending their weekly classes! Classes are now learning their dances for the Summer show!

All one hour Intro Ballet, Ballet 1, Ballet 2, Ballet 3 & Pointe!! Please wear ballet clothing and have hair pulled in a bun. Bring plenty of water! Drop off only!

<u>DTA PICTURE DAY IS JUNE 14th: 10am-4pm at DTA!</u> DaSilva Photography will be taking our pictures again this year. The picture lineup will be posted at the studio, posted on our website dancersturnout.net and the Remind app. All dancers should attend for the group photo. Purchase is not required.

- Your dancer will need to be dressed in their costume, with the hair, shoes, makeup and accessories that are on the costume list at the studio.
- If purchasing pictures, Please fill out a picture form by scanning the QR Code available in the lobby beginning June 1st.
- Individual pictures are available to take following your group pic.

MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL (All REC Classes, Snow White Ballet, & comp dances) IS SATURDAY, JUNE 21st @ DORE THEATER (CSUB). It will be from 9:30am-6pm for rec classes and comp dances & for the full Snow White ballet.

- Show and rehearsal assignments/times will be posted in the lobby, as well as remind and the DTA website www.dancersturnout.net
- The dances are placed in blocks of approximately 1 hour for blocking, lighting, and run-through. After they've rehearsed, they will be dismissed to the pickup area. For their safety, dancers will not be allowed to walk themselves to the parking lot.
- ONE PARENT is allowed in the auditorium with the dancer. Please no extra siblings.
- Please plan to arrive 15 prior to your block time.
- Proper hair, makeup, costume, tights (if applicable), dance shoes, and all accessories are REQUIRED. Label costumes. Bring extra makeup, hair gel/spray, hairnets, pins, safety pins, etc.

Only WATER is permitted inside the auditorium. Any snacks must be consumed in the
designated areas. We know it is a long day for some, please help us keep the auditorium
clean and follow the rules.

We will have three shows on SUNDAY, JUNE 22ND (11am, 2:30pm & 6:30pm). The Snow White Ballet will perform in the 2:30pm and 6:30pm shows!

The line up will be posted May 15th!

- Call Times 6/22 Matinee 11am: Arrival time 10:30am rec/10am comp. No Snow White Ballet.
- Call Times 6/22 Afternoon 2:30pm: Arrival time 2pm rec/1:30pm comp & Snow White Ballet.
- Call Times 6/22 Evening 6:30pm: Arrival time 6pm rec/ 5:30pm comp & Snow White Ballet.
- Shows consist of our ballet "Snow White", our amazing recreational classes as well as some of our amazing DTA Competition Groups. All shows are a balance of all of the wonderful aspects of everything DTA has to offer.
- We will NOT have a professional videographer this year. Please feel free to video your child's routine without distracting others around you. No standing up in audience to record. One policy stays the same...ABSOLUTELY NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY ALLOWED. This is for the safety of all performers.
- HAIR AND MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS-The Theater has professional grade lighting. It's very bright, and without makeup the dancers' faces will be washed out onstage. Dancers should wear foundation one shade darker than their skin color (blend well), eye shadow (smokey), eyeliner, deep rose colored blush, and a deep red lipstick. Dancers are allowed to wear false lashes. Unless otherwise indicated by your child's instructor, hair must be slicked back from face using hair gel, and secured tightly into a center part low bun for ballet. Cover with hairnet (available at drugstores) and secure with hairpins. For other hairstyles please make sure to slick and use gel and hairspray and secure tightly.
- COSTUMES AND ACCESSORIES- Label everything. Please, no panties under the costumes. Like bathing suits, costumes are lined. Having them show during the performance is embarrassing for the dancer. If you're wearing costumes with tights, have an additional new pair on hand, in case your dancer gets a hole or stain, etc. Please bring additional makeup, hair supplies, etc TO THE AUDITORIUM for touch ups etc.
- Room moms will be assigned to all Tutu and PreK age classes. Room moms will be responsible for sitting with their assigned class during dress rehearsal and the recital. Room mom details will be given as each teacher chooses one for each class.
- **Dressing Rooms:** If your dancer is using the dressing rooms PLEASE help them to clean up after themselves. Every year we pick up A TON of trash left by our dancers. The auditorium is now charging an extra fee for additional messes left by our dancers. Please double check their area and make sure it's clean when you leave.
