SUMMERLIN AVENUE WORK TO BEGIN

The big utility project to replace the nearly 100-year-old water lines under Summerlin Avenue that have caused potholes over the years has finally begun. The road will be closed one block at a time during construction to minimize impacts. The OUC and City of Orlando modernization project involves the removal and replacement of existing water mains, valves, and the addition of new fire hydrants to bolster safety measures. The gravity-fed sewers along Summerlin Avenue will be replaced, lined and have point repairs, along with upgraded manholes and sewer laterals. A proper road base will be built with the surface bricks reset. Work is slated to run from 7am through 5pm Mondays through Fridays with some weekend or night work. The Robinson & Summerlin intersection is closed for the first 90 days.
