

## Review of recent events by ISA Pune



Our signature event, 3rd Industrial IoT Virtual Conference & Exhibition, held on January 16th 2021, was hugely successful, being the first Virtual Conference conducted due to prevailing condition of COVID-19.

It had highly curated 3 sessions; I -Use Case Presentations from End Users, II - Panel Discussions and III- Tech Tech Medley, dedicated to showcase latest technologies in the field of Industrial IoT. A concurrent exhibition was the icing on the cake and had as many as 251 booth visits for viewing the videos, browsing catalogs or downloads.

The conference had a good response for delegate registration of 769 and a total of 413 delegate log-ins, with an average attendance of 200 delegates all the time.

Many virtual activities and events



While the world was pandemic challenged completing their activities, Student Section found a way out to keep student members engaged in learning through the hands on workshops, competitions and webinars.

Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune successfully hosted 7 workshops on various latest tools like App Development, ROS, Python, IIOT and Industrial Automation. # **Cybersecurity Training Course**

IC-32IN and IC-33IN Cybersecurity Training Course planned for 5th-9th July 2021

ISA Pune announces ISA/IEC62443 Cybersecurity Certificate Program, the first virtual training in India!

#### Use the ISA/IEC62443 Standards to secure your control systems (IC32IN VILT): 5th & 6th July, 2021

The move to using open standards such as Ethernet, TCP/IP and web technologies in supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) and process control networks has begun to expose systems to the same cyberattacks that have wreaked so much havoc on corporate information systems.

With the introduction of the new UKHSE Operational Guidance OG-0086, the need to understand the fundamentals of control system security has never been more important. This course provides a detailed look at how the ISA/IEC62443 standards can be used to protect your critical control systems. It also explores the procedural and technical differences between the security for traditional IT environments and those solutions appropriate for SCADA or plant floor environments.

The next training course is Assessing the Cybersecurity of New or Existing IACS Systems (IC33INVILT).

#### Assessing the Cybersecurity of New or Existing IACS Systems (IC-33INVILT): 7th-9th July 2021

The first phase in the IACS Cybersecurity Lifecycle (definedinISA62443-1-1) is to identify and document IACS assets and perform a cybersecurity vulnerability and risk assessment in order to identify and understand the high-risk vulnerabilities that require mitigation. Per ISA62443-2-1 these assessments need to be performed on both new (i.e. greenfield) and existing (i.e. brownfield) applications. Part of the assessment process involves developing a zone and conduit model of the system, identifying security level targets, and documenting the cybersecurity requirements into a cybersecurity requirements specification (CRS).
