Potential Horse Evaluation

The initial interview process to bring a horse into training here at Painted Dreams Horsemanship is crucial to both the horse, the owner, and Brittany.

The first step in having your horse evaluated is to fill out the attached information sheet and email it back to gh.painted.dreams@gmail.com Brittanys personal email.

After your evaluation sheet is reviewed, we will either call or email you to discuss your horse and make sure they qualify for Brittanys Training Program. We do not want to put the horse or trainer (Brittany) at risk, if the horse is deemed too dangerous for the owner and Brittany both, for safety reasons Brittany will turn the horse down. We do ask for quite a bit of information on the horse/horses behavior, only to figure out what issues your horse has, and what Brittany needs to work on with the horse.

We do require a current coggins (copy to be kept with Brittany with the word COPY for TRAINING wrote up top), worming to be kept UTD, vaccine schedule to be kept UTD, we do ask that you keep up with farrier visits (our farrier Grace Shriner) at the farm on Tuesdays usually every 6 weeks) whether you use our farrier or your own (you will be asked to come out on your farrier visit unless it is a Sunday or Tuesday when Brittany can be at the farm at any time frame).
