## Some Details...

Wednesday 5/20/26 – Brooklyn Botanic Garden, Brooklyn, New York City. Comprises 52 acres of gardens, begun in 1911. Includes bonsai museum, water gardens, woodland garden, conservatory, children's discovery garden, native flora garden, rose garden, herb garden, one of the oldest public Japanese gardens in the U. S., and more. And now, of course, guest iris gardens.

Thursday 5/21/26 - Presby Memorial Iris Gardens, 474 Upper Mountain Avenue, Upper Montclair, NJ. In addition to guest irises, there are a large number of historic irises in numerous garden beds, a bed of irises planted for the 2020 International Iris Competition, and a dedicated bed of Paul Black irises. Also, a gift shop.

Friday 5/22/26 - Rutgers Gardens, New Brunswick, NJ. On 130 acres and is the official botanical garden of Rutgers University, located on the Rutgers-New Brunswick campus. The gardens consist of designed gardens, farms, plant collections, natural habitats, and a farmers market (on Fridays, when we will be visiting). A large area is now dedicated to guest irises in a prominent part of the gardens.

Saturday 5/23/26 - Gary Slagle Garden (Phanaticville), South Market Street, Gibbstown, NJ. This is the master planting for the 2026 convention. It is the only private garden, and located downstate, near Philadelphia.
