- Co-op grant monitoring submitted, £1.4k spent and remainder committed with detailed plan on how to utilise. Anticipate fully spent by end of September 2024.
- Application submitted for Co-op fund 2024/2025 for Pavilion toilet improvements. It was suggested a small cupboard also be installed if possible.
- CIL grant has been submitted.
- Thank you letter to be sent to Barbour regarding utilisation of Barbour grant.

6) Crawcrook Pavilion & Green:

- a) First Aid course arranged for 12th August. Water heaters to be fitted that day.
- b) Storage Planning application No further forward with this at this point in time.
- c) Community Café update (SD/DM/CB/KH/LC)
 - i) Cleaning paperwork topic reiterated. These needs to be up to date and clean down checks need completing every time the café closes/opens.
 - ii) More volunteers needed for café with a 2-hour Level 2 Hygiene course offered. Linda Chappell has volunteered. Chris to contact Gillian. Tammy from the Hub coming in next Thursday.
 - iii) Chris looking in to WIFI as card reader not working due to weak reception. A notice to be put in Facebook asking people to bring cash.
 - iv) Chris looking into possibility of new easy to use till containing pictures of items sold.
 - v) Plan for summer period New menu to be drafted offering hot dogs, toasties, pie & pea as well as pick and mix sweet bags. Meeting to be arranged to discuss in more detail.
- d) Summer holiday lawn games/activities on the green (BW) Set dates and decide volunteers Café hours? Ongoing.
- e) Fence Update (CB/LC) Laura has chased Gateshead Council again, we have agreed to a fence at a cost of £13.3k and some sundry expenses to be confirmed. Fence is being fabricated and Gateshead council have removed/removing 133 stumps! Still ongoing.
- f) Further Project Payback sessions (All) Boot camp? Graffiti workshop? DJ workshop? Buskers on the green with picnics? Ongoing.
- g) Sculpture Trail (LC) Need an installation date from the council. Kathryn please can you push them? Ongoing.
- h) Park security following the recent incidents in the Young Children's play area (CB). Flasher twice caught on CCTV but not recognisable. Has also been seed in Prudhoe.
