4) Crawcrook Pavilion & Green

- a) Pavilion works The Café counter cannot be lowered until some electrical works have been completed. **ACTION: CB**
- b) Community Café update The café is still quiet at the moment. Will continue with 3 days per week. Warm Spaces offer free tea/coffee soup and a sandwich. **ACTION: JG** to create new posters for local shops and Facebook to advertise..

- c) Classes for PCC funding. Discussions and follow up needed re: taster sessions after the Easter break for 1st Aid (KH) Yoga (HH?), Tai Chi, Personal Trainer sessions on the green (CB), card making, Mental Health sessions for men (CB).
- d) Bowling Green update (/LC) No update so far. Carry forward to the next meeting.
- e) Fence Update (CB) Needs to comply with H&S regs. Gateshead council have quoted £15.7k for Palisade fencing and £20.2k for Bow top fencing. As palisade fencing has a spiked top this is deemed inappropriate for a children's play area, Chris will clarify the safety of the fencing with the council and see if any reduction could be made on cost **ACTION: CB.**

5) Review of regular activities:

a) Litter Picking:

i) General Update – 3 Volunteers lost and 1 gained (Sally Hirton). Sally has been allocated picking equipment. Any new volunteers to get in touch with OV. Discussions took place around the amount of dog faeces in the Park and generally along paths towards schools. Thoughts on a new and graphic poster to inform the public of health dangers.

b) Gardening: (SW)

ii) General update: — Lots of positive comments from the public on how fresh the park and the pinfold is looking. Many thanks to our gardening volunteers for all of their hard work and dedication in keeping borders and other planted areas looking good, even through such bad weather.

6) Community Garden Update (LC/BW)

- i) Access update Paddy Gascoigne has written to appeal to the Council's rejection for an access request. The letter addresses the Council's concerns and demonstrates counter arguments. He proposes a trial access with a wooden (temporary) gate to see how it goes.
- ii) The Probation Service contact is looking for community activities to take place in the garden.
- iii) We need a skip to clear the bags of soil from the community garden. Then the next job will be a seating area when the ground is flattened and flagged.
