





ABOUT THE SERIES







THE LATEST DETECTIVE DRAMA


FIRST SEASON

The season concludes with the resolution of the case, while also introducing new challenges and conflicts for Evelyn, Dectitive Porter, and the rest of the department to address in upcoming seasons.







EPISODES

FORMAT: 45 MINUTE CRIME DRAMA SERIES.

Each episode of Under Investigation will spotlight a different injustice case, featuring Evelyn and Detective Porter collaborating to collect evidence, interview witnesses, and ultimately crack the cases. Nevertheless, everyone is innocent until proven guilty. The series will also explore into the characters' personal lives and relationships, offering a deeper insight into their motivations and internal struggles.

- SOCIAL ISSUES ADVOCATES: INDIVIDUALS INTERESTED IN EXPLORING SOCIAL ISSUES SUCH AS POVERTY, CHILD WELFARE, MENTAL HEALTH, AND FAMILY DYNAMICS WILL FIND VALUE IN THE STORIES PRESENTED, AS THEY REFLECT REALWORLD CHALLENGES AND HUMAN EXPERIENCES.
- FANS OF PROCEDURAL DRAMAS: THOSE WHO ENJOY THE THRILL OF PROCEDURAL STORYTELLING, INCLUDING SOLVING CASES AND NAVIGATING LEGAL COMPLEXITIES, WILL APPRECIATE ANY PROCEDURAL ELEMENTS INTEGRATED INTO THE SERIES.
