


# FYI... The Sollers Point Multi-Purpose Center 323 Sollers Point Rd.

#### 911...THIS IS AN EMERGENCY!!

In the event of a flood, hurricane, tornado, earthquake, fire or hazardous material incident, the Baltimore County Office of Emergency Management and the local fire and police departments will tell us to either stay in our homes or evacuate. They will notify us by corded phones, local radio and television stations. Every household should prepare to have enough food, water and other supplies to get along for 72 hours following an emergency.

#### What is recycling?

It is one of the most important things we can do to preserve our planet. We can "reduce, reuse, and recycle" by placing all of these items in the same bin: bottles, newspaper, cardboard, plastic, cans, etc.

Recyclables are picked up on Tuesday mornings. Regular trash pick-up is on Friday mornings.

#### What if I see a rat in the neighborhood?

#### How can I be rid of rats?

**Don't feed them.** They love to eat pet food, pet waste, trash from open garbage cans, trash from cans with loose lids, bags of garbage not in cans, bird seed on the ground, and food scraps left out.

Clean up outside eating areas after a BBQ or cookout. Grease and food residue will attract them.

Replace trash cans that have holes. Rats can slip through spaces the size of a quarter.

Pick up after your pets! Rats love animal waste - scoop if your pooch poops!
