SERGEANT MAJOR (RET) BOB McDONALD RETURNS TO McCOY'S GRAND FOR THE VETERANS CONCERT ON NOVEMBER 15



The Annual Veteran Concert will feature **Sergeant Major (ret) Bob McDonald** along with West Virginia native **Sergeant Major (ret) Tony Nalker** on the keyboard. The evening will feature a salute to veterans along with classics from the American Songbook, showtunes and more. Bob most recently appeared on the McCoy's Grand stage in 2024 with *A SINATRA CHRISTMAS*. The concert will be **November 15 at 7pm**. Tickets are \$15.00 for adults and \$10 for students and are available to purchase at mccoysgrand.org.

SGM (ret) Bob McDonald, Baritone, served as Group Leader and a member of the U.S. Army Chorus for over 26 years, retiring in 2020. In this capacity, he performed regularly at the White House and for visiting dignitaries from across the globe. Bob is a regular fixture of the D.C. musical theatre and cabaret scene, and he has performed at such venues as The Kennedy Center, Folger Theatre, AMP by Strathmore, Wolf Trap, and Signature Theatre, among others. Bob is a familiar face to Washington Capitals fans, gearing up for his 32nd season of singing the National Anthem for the hockey team. He has also sung the National Anthem for many other professional sports events in the D.C. area and across the country, including the Super Bowl, and was a soloist for Game 5 of the 2019 World Series. Bob received his B.A. in Vocal Performance and his M.A. in Opera Directing from Oberlin Conservatory of Music.

SGM (ret) Tony Nalker performs widely in Washington, D.C., currently serving as jazz pianist with the Smithsonian Jazz Masterworks Orchestra and the National Symphony Orchestra Pops. From 1989-2016 Tony was the pianist of the premiere jazz ensemble of the U.S. Army, the Army Blues, and served as the group's enlisted leader. As a military musician, Nalker played for the highest levels of the U.S. government and military and performed on USO tours to Iraq and Afghanistan. He has also performed on State Department sponsored musical diplomacy tours to Russia, Kenya, and Ethiopia. He received his undergraduate degree from James Madison University and an M.A. from the University of Iowa.

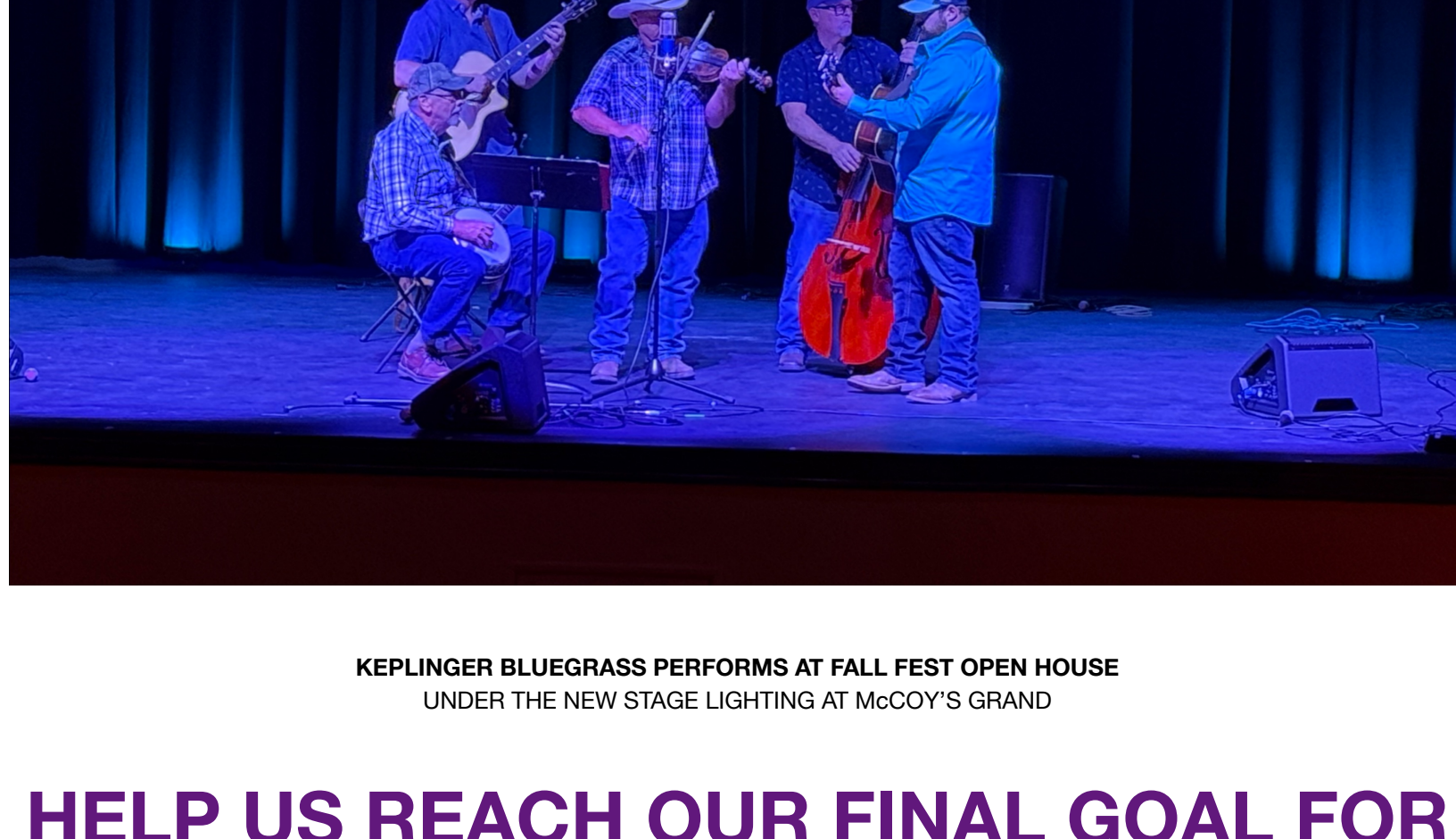
