
### WHAT CAN McCOY'S AUDIENCES EXPECT FROM YOUR CONCERT?


So...full band, pretty lights, talented locals-- that about sums it up.

## **McCOY'S GRAND CAPITAL CAMPAIGN**

McCoy's Grand has embarked on a new capital campaign - CURTAIN UP! LIGHT THE LIGHTS! to replace the existing lighting and sound equipment in the theatre. The current lighting instruments are over 30 years old and we can't even find replacement bulbs. The sound equipment is over 25 years old as well. The new campaign is underway with plans to make the new upgrades in August 2025. Working with Pittsburgh Stage, the new lighting and sound will be state of the art LED technology that will help increase productions as well as technical times at the theatre. McCoy's recently was awarded a \$50,000.00 check from the Burke & Herbert
