



TAX RELIEF FOR MISSOURI SENIORS AND DISABLED

The Missouri Property Tax Credit allows a credit to certain senior citizens and 100% disabled individuals based on total household income (taxable and nontaxable) and the amount of property taxes or rent paid. The credit is for a maximum of \$750 for renters and \$1,100 for those who own and occupy a home.

MO HealthNet (Medicaid) To see if you qualify, call the Family Support Division at (855) 373-4636.

Medicine Assistance Tool (MAT) The MAT helps the uninsured and under-insured get pr'escription medications from existing patient assistance programs. Find MAT online at medicineassistancetool.org.



Rx Outreach is a nonprofit mail order pharmacy that provides affordable medications for people in need.
