Become a Block Link!

Block Links (otherwise known as block Captains) are volunteers in our neighborhood. They attend neighborhood and police meetings, pay attention, ask questions and pass along information to others on their block. Block Links encourage neighbors to attend those same meetings. Block Links distribute a list of everyone on the block and their phone numbers and/or emails, so that everyone can keep in touch. During **OperationBright Side Blitz** in the spring and other alley clean ups, block links organize neighbors to clean up their streets, alleys, park and vacant lots. Block Links report burned-out street and alley lights to authorities. Block Links report problems to the **Citizen Service Bureau**. For **National Night Out**, block links either host a block party or encourage their block to attend a neighborhood wide event. Block Links identify people on their block who may be able to **volunteer** for neighborhood clean ups, Court Watch, mobile patrol, Juvenile Accountability board, events, mailings, etc. Block Links are invaluable as they work hand-in-hand with neighbors to check on the elderly and disabled, encourage neighbors to report crime and problems, and link with neighboring blocks to improve our community.

Block Links don't spy. Block Links pay attention!
