FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How long will my house take to build?

That will depend on the size of your home and will be discussed with you at proposal stage. Usually this would take 12 weeks. Subject to pandemic impacted delays.

How much deposit do I need?

Usually 50% deposit to start, unless prior arrangement. Payments are done in stages.

How would I pay for my house?

Bank Transfer or Bank cheque.

What approvals do I need?

Every Council has different requirements. Please contact your local Certifier for your location. Alternatively, this is an additional upgrade for us to provide this service for you.

What warranty do I get?

Each material supplier has their own warranty. Structural warranty refer to your local building code.



Is there after sales service?

Our dedicated team are here to assist you with any questions you have before, during and after your project has been completed.

What are your operating hours?

Our Team schedule of work is usually Monday to Thursday 7am to 5pm.
