CT Yankee Council's Camp Sequassen – Week 3 July 14-20, 2019

Important Information:

Review summer camp packets issued at March's PSG. Notify ASAP to Scoutmaster Roger Williams or ASM Jim O'Leary if your son is attending this year.

Cost per Boy: \$485 Checks payable to "Troop 9" (for additional scouts in family, subtract \$40). Cost includes camp registration (\$455), group picture (\$10) and 2 new troop class "B" t-shirts (\$20). Pocket cash for Scouts for the week should be approximately \$20-\$45 depending on individual activities. Payment for Summer Camp anytime now thru June 1st. Payments received after April 14th will incur \$25 late fee. Please give to Roger Williams or Peter Eldredge. The sooner payment is received, the sooner Scouts can be signed up for Merit Badges and other activities (some Merit Badges/activities are first come, first accepted!). Camp site will again be the "Eli Whitney" tent site in North Sequassen.

ALL attendees MUST complete (including all wet signatures) a standard BSA Medical Form Parts A, B & C along with addendums specifically for State of CT and Sequassen Summer Camp!!!
