## WEDDING DAY EMERGENCY CHECKLIST

Pack these items in your wedding emergency bag and get hitched without a hitch! Don't forget your phone, ID and wallet - whether it's in the emergency bag or another.
$\square$ Lipstick and other make-up
$\square$ Q-tips, makeup remover, blotting papers and tissues
$\square$ Toothbrush/toothpaste/Dental floss/toothpicks
$\square$ Water bottle and straws (keep hydrated without messing up your lipstick)
$\square$ Pair of nylons and extra undergarments
$\square$ Small sewing kit with scissors, needles, thread, buttons, and safety pins
$\square$ Nail Polish and a nail file (one clear top coat; one in the shade you're wearing. Whether it's a chipped nail or a stocking run, you will be prepared!)
$\square$ Tampons/panty liners
$\square$ Basic First Aid Kit with Band-Aids, antiseptic, liquid bandages, blister prevention/friction stick and unscented sunscreen and bugspray
$\square$ Medicine (pain reliever, allergy medicine, antacid)
$\square$ Deodorant, towelettes and baby powder (stay clean and fresh)
$\square$ Razor, tweezers and small scissors
$\square$ Easy to carry snacks
$\square$ Super Glue and White Duct Tape (now you can fix anything!)
$\square$ Pen and paper
$\square$ Breath mints (pop one in right before heading down the aisle)
$\square$ Stain remover pen and white chalk (if a stain just won't come out, you can usually mask the stain with chalk)
$\square$ Lighter (to seal frayed edges)
$\square$ Lint roller
$\square$ Hairspray, comb/brush, hair elastics and bobby pins
$\square$ Lotion
$\square$ Extension cord and phone charger(s)
$\square$ Eye drops (get rid of any red eyes so the photographer doesn't have to later!)
