


How can we build a sure-footed faith on a foundation which will not crumble?







Framework is defined as:

What's A Christian Worldview?

A nationwide survey completed by the Barna Research Group determined that only 4 percent of Americans had a "biblical" worldview, and among 'born- again' believers in America, the results were only 9 percent!

Barna says, "Although most people own a Bible and know some of its content, our research found that most Americans have little idea how to integrate core biblical principles to form a unified and meaningful response to the challenges and opportunities of life."

Here are the questions, based on claims found in the Bible, which George Barna used in his survey:

• Do absolute moral truths exist?

• Is absolute truth defined by the Bible?

• Did Jesus Christ live a sinless life?

• Is God the all-powerful and all-knowing Creator of the universe, and does He still rule it today?

- Is salvation a gift from God that cannot be earned?
- Is Satan real?
- Does a Christian have a responsibility to share his or her faith in Christ with other people?
- Is the Bible accurate in all of its teachings?

Did you answer yes to these? Only 9 percent of "born- again" believers did.

How did a biblical worldview get diluted?

The constant bombardment with nonbiblical worldviews in television, movies, music, books, magazines and the classrooms of America have been a huge influence in shaping how we see the world.

At times we are not even aware of the things we have incorporated into our worldview.

Secular thought has so permeated our culture that it is sometimes difficult to even spot it in our views on history, law, science and ethics.

Without a little background on secular humanist thought, it's very easy to just go with the flow and not recognize that you are veering off in the direction which the apostle Paul warned us about in Colossians 2:8 which says, "Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ."

Secular Humanism Ethics: Ethical Relativism

Since the Humanist rejects the existence of God, human beings get to decide on standards and values. Humanists believe that science, reason, and historical experience are sufficient guides for figuring out what is right or wrong in any situation. These standards will not always be the same, as each person has a different background and reasoning. Therefore, the standards and values – ethics – are relative. The Humanist Manifesto II states, "We affirm that moral values derive their source from human experience. Ethics is autonomous and situational, needing not theological or ideological sanction. Ethics stems from human need and interest."

Humanist Manifesto I, written in 1933, talked of a new "religion", and referred to Humanism as "a religious movement to transcend and replace previous religions that were based on allegations of supernatural revelation." Humanist Manifesto II, written in 1973 states that "No deity will save us; we must save ourselves." And then it tells

must save ourselves." And then it tells of the plans for the public education of our children...

John Dunphy wrote:

"I am convinced that the battle for humankind's future must be waged and won in the public school classroom by teachers that correctly perceive their role as proselytizers of a new faith: a religion of humanity that recognizes and respects the spark of what theologians call divinity in every human being ...

"The classroom must and will become an arena of conflict between the old and new the rotting corpse of Christianity, together with all its adjacent evils and misery, and the new faith of humanism..."

"Fading Faith: new trends show secularism is booming, even in the seemingly pious United States." (Cover of Free Inquiry Magazine)

"A historic transition is occurring, barely noticed. Slowly, quietly, imperceptibly, religion is shriveling in America, as it already has in Europe, Canada, Australia, Japan – across the developed world. Increasingly, supernatural faith belongs to the third world. The first world is entering the long-predicted Secular Age, when science and knowledge dominate."

A generation of Americans are building their worldview on secular humanist "religion" while Christianity is being eliminated from the public sector and mocked.

"Whatever we (America) once were, we are no longer. We have changed," said Ken Ham, president of Answers in Genesis, in his second State of the Nation address. "Most of the founding fathers of this nation ... built the worldview of this nation on the authority of the Word of God," he said. "Because of that, there have been reminders in this culture concerning God's Word, the God of creation."

Ham, who leads the Creation Museum near Cincinnati, said those reminders have been and are progressively being removed, and younger generations are increasingly abandoning God's Word and making "man's word" their foundation.

"Do you realize what they're saying to the students in this nation? They're saying 'when you look at the universe, life, mankind, all of reality, the supernatural has nothing to do with it. Everything is explained by natural processes." "That's the religion of atheism, naturalism," he pointed out. "They've actually thrown out Christianity and replaced it with a different religion."

The foundations in America are shifting from moral absolutes (the Word of God) to moral relativism (man's word), Ham indicated.

Now that they have built their foundation, Ham predicts the secular humanist will become much more aggressive, and he sees that Christians are slowly shrinking back and compromising the Word of God.

GRAND RAPIDS, MI—Stating the new edition of the Scriptures would allow Christians to remove doctrines, verses, and entire books of the Bible they find unpopular or inconvenient, Zondervan Publishing announced Tuesday a new Bible with micro-perforated, completely removable pages. "Don't like some of the heavyhanded calls to repentance, whether in the New Testament or Old? Now you can just rip that page right out," a representative for the publisher said in an over-the-phone interview. "If you're reading through an epistle and the author calls you to the carpet on one of your pet sins, you can just crumple that page up and toss it right in the trash."

"The bottom line is, if you stumble across a snippet of the Word that's hard for you to swallow, now you can just get rid of it," the rep added. Zondervan further claimed that internal tests showed a massive improvement in the devotional lives of users of the Bible, who reported that they enjoyed the Word of God more than ever."

"People are far more likely to daily pick up their Bible if they know it's not going to convict them of their sin, make them uncomfortable, or confront their faulty thinking on an issue. The NIV Perforated Bible makes that dream into a reality." Are you shocked? So was I, and then I scrolled down to the bottom of the page and saw this:


