Does Your Life Portray These Qualities To Others?


- Faith (complete trust and confidence in God)
- <u>Virtue</u> (behavior showing high moral standards)
- Knowledge (of God's Word)
- <u>Self-control</u> (the ability to control oneself, in particular one's emotions and desires or the expression of them in one's behavior, especially in difficult situations.)

Does Your Life Portray These Qualities To Others?

- <u>Steadfastness</u> (being dutifully firm and unwavering)
- Godliness (conforming to the laws and wishes of God)
- Brotherly affection (the natural affection associated with near kin)
- Love (selfless and unconditional)

Love, the Essential Ingredient 1 Corinthians 13:1-3

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink.


