

DIRECTORS' NOTE

"There's a light in the darkness of everybody's life."

Thank you for seeing Muir Musical's production of *The Rocky Horror Show*! We are extremely excited to take you through a night of science fiction, love, lust, and **radical self-discovery**.

From the moment we first saw the show live, we fell in love with it. The Rocky Horror Show inspired us to think about the existence of gender in our heteronormative society. More often than not, those who do not exist within the binary are severely underrepresented and misrepresented, especially on stage. Our goal with this production is to empower the LGBTQ+ community at UC San Diego, celebrate queer relationships, and find freedom to just be in a world that discourages authenticity.

The Rocky Horror Show is an important story to tell today. It has reclaimed what queer identities represent in our cisgendered society, and it continues to challenge heteronormative traditions. For many, including ourselves, this show is the "light" that illuminates our existence in the world and how we as a community can learn to be liberated from hate. We encourage you to give in to absolute pleasure, become radically activated, and honor the light for queer theater as The Rocky Horror Show may shock you, make you uncomfortable, or even seduce you.

We hope this show inspires you to see past the heteronormative standards engrained in our American culture. We challenge you to think beyond the binary and truly experience our shared humanity through the out-of-worldly story that is *The Rocky Horror Show*.

OUR HISTORY

Muir Musical was launched in 1991 by a Muir College sophomore, Orren Webber, who had a vision to provide an outlet for students interested in musical theatre who were not necessarily theatre majors.

Before graduating, Orren directed the Muir Musical's first three productions: *Pippin*, *Into the Woods*, and *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat*. Except for one single-year hiatus, the Muir Musical has put on a full-scale Broadway musical production every year since its inception.

The legacy that Mr. Webber created has had a significant impact on the UC San Diego campus and in the lives of the thousands of students who work in or enjoy its productions each year. Today, Muir Musical's productions are considered annual arts events that bring UCSD students, faculty, staff, and community members together.

After our production of *Pippin* was tragically canceled in 2020 due to safety concerns in the ongoing pandemic, Muir Musical produced our first-ever original show, a song cycle titled *Project Symphony*, and shortly after produced our first full-scale digital musical with *Big Fish* in May 2021. In December 2021, we returned with our grand in-person performance of *A Chorus Line*. We closed our 21-22 season with *American Idiot* in April 2022. This production of *The Rocky Horror Show* will be the first cabaret-style immersive show to be produced with the organization. We look forward to continuing our legacy into the future - creating incredible musicals for our audience to enjoy.
