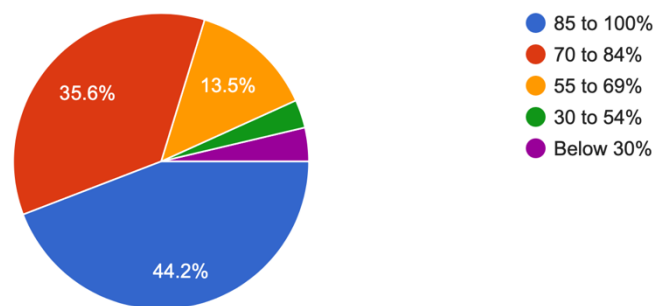


# Students Satisfaction Survey Report for Academic year 2021-22

We collected Student Satisfaction Survey response from 166 students from different departments. Results are given below.

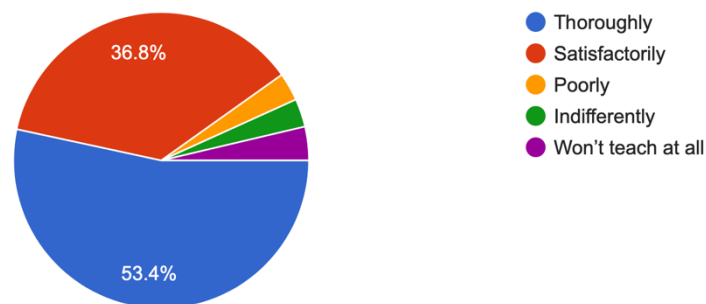
## 1.How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

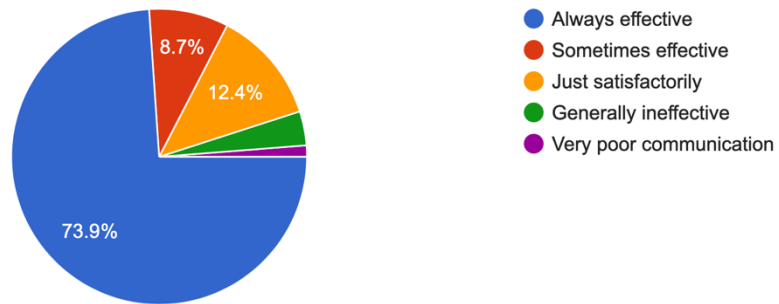
## 2.How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

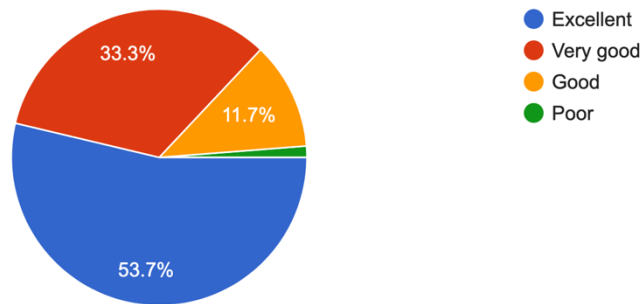
### 3.How well were the teachers able to communicate?

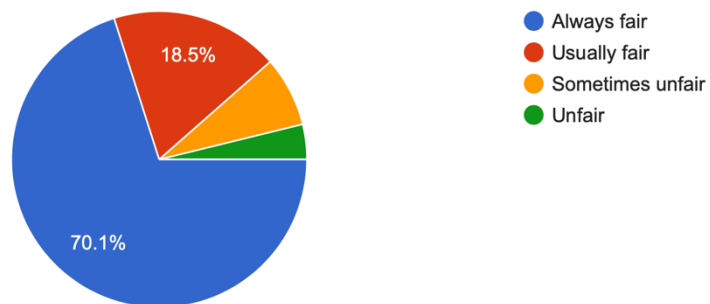
### 4.The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

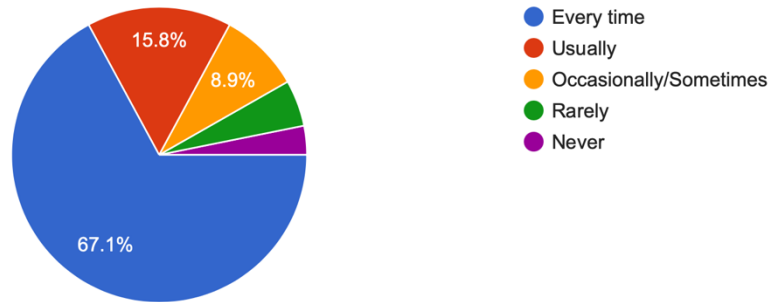

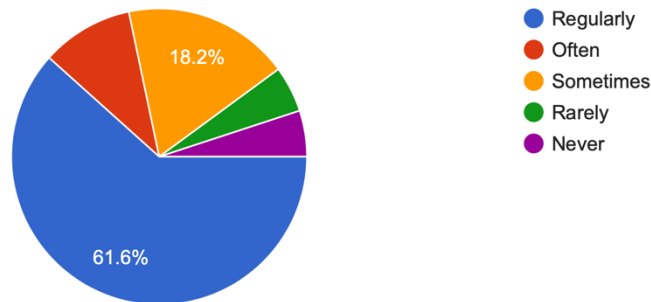

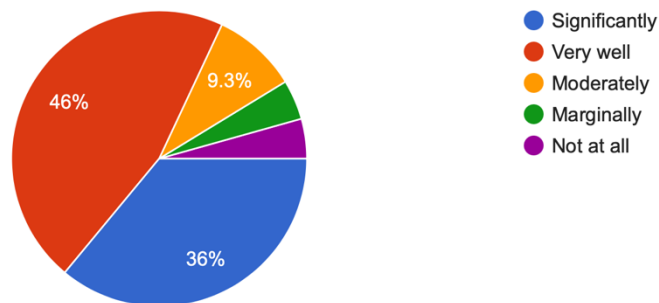

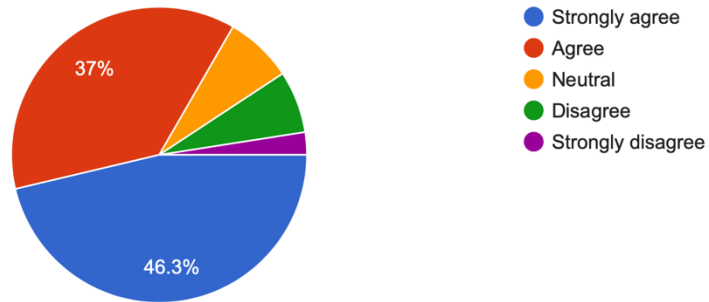

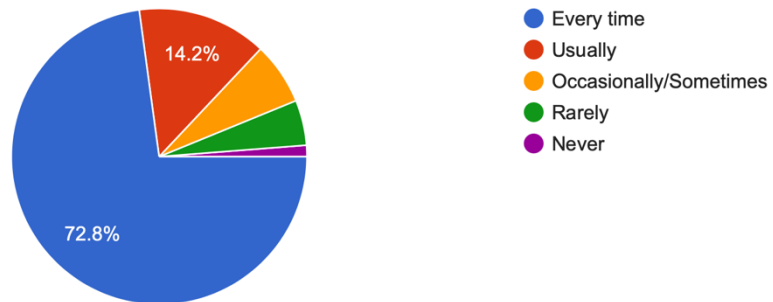

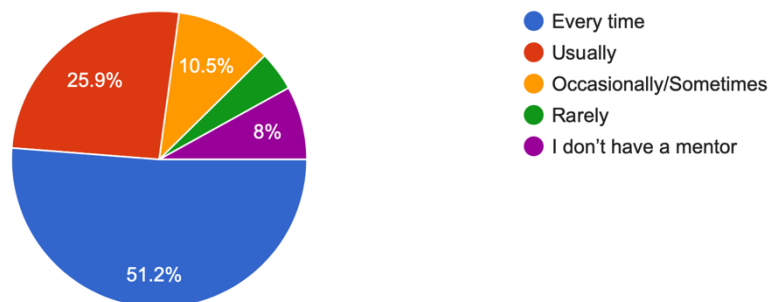

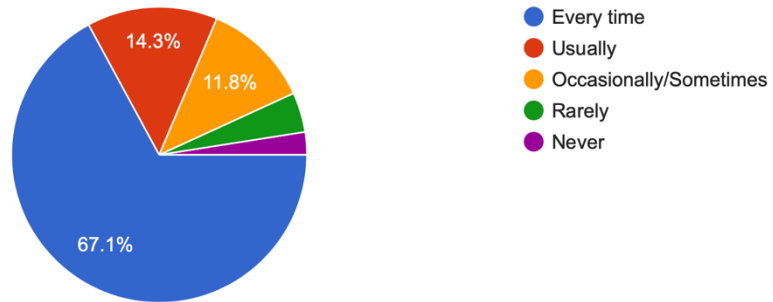

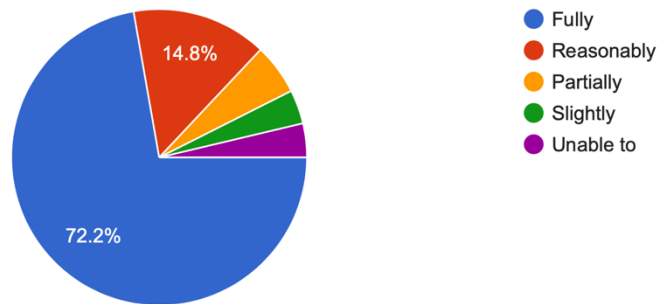

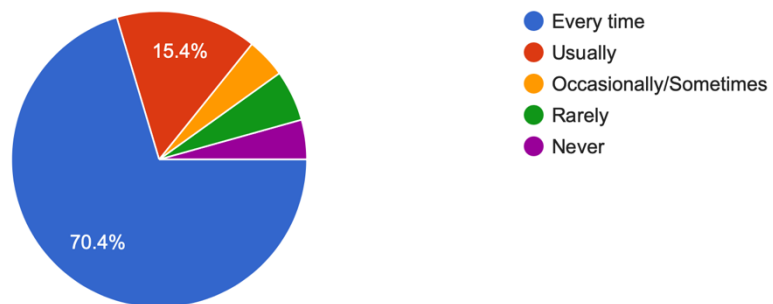

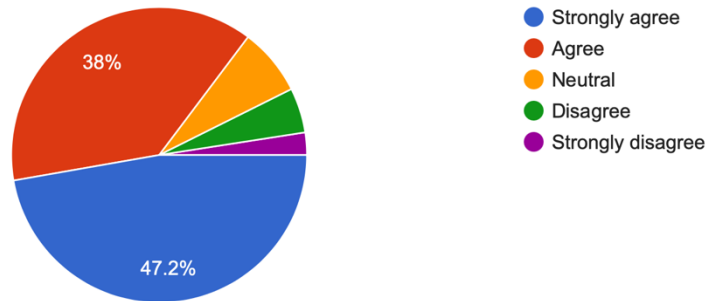

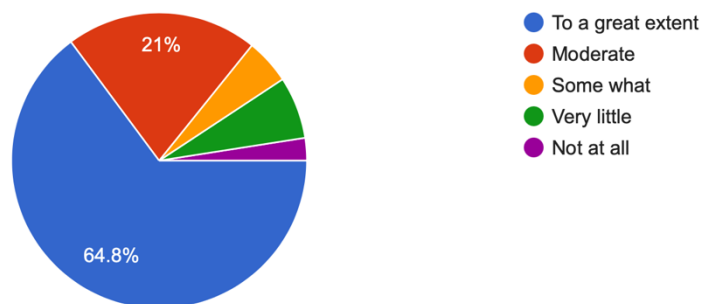

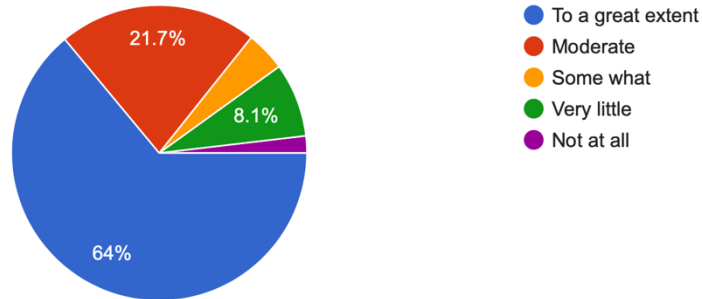

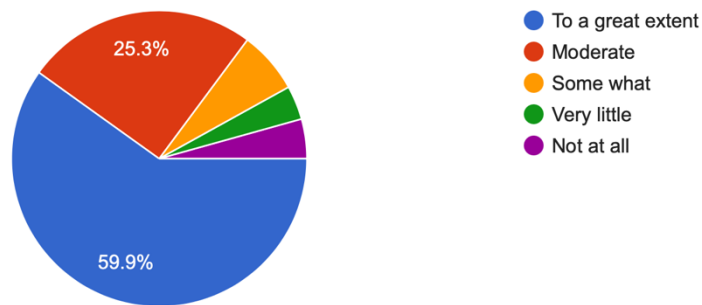

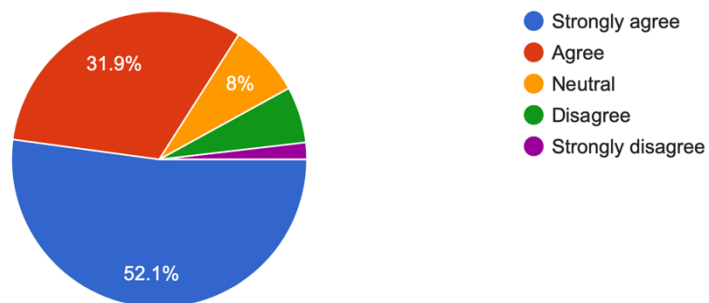

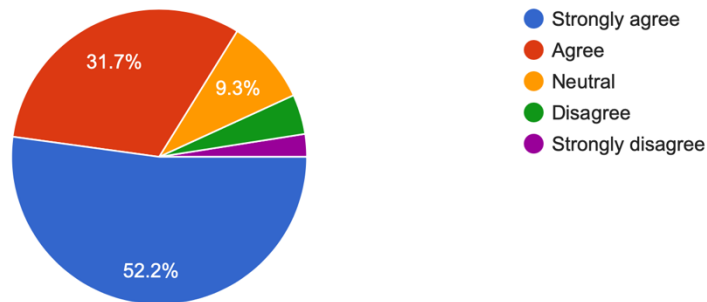

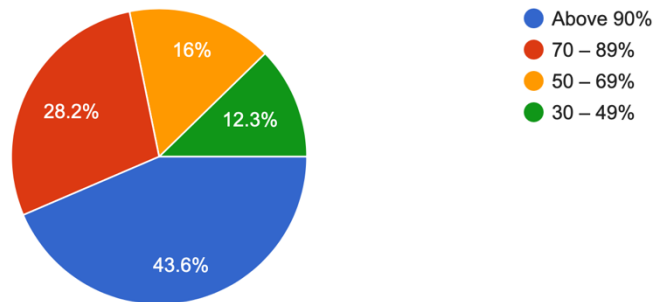
20.The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

### 1. Teaching Methodology:

- 1.2. Incorporate technology, graphics, and multimedia resources for better engagement.
- 1.3. Foster a two-way interaction in teaching.
- 1.4. Reflect on and appreciate diverse learning styles.
- 1.5. Lesson planning and reflective teaching are crucial.
- 1.6. Utilize quizzes, challenges, and group activities.

### 2. College Infrastructure & Management:

- 2.1. Address low attendance and discipline issues.



- 2.2. Ensure regular classes, both offline and online.
- 2.3. Bus facilities are essential for student convenience.
- 2.4. Maintain cleanliness and ensure proper facilities like libraries.
- 2.5. Demand for more teachers, especially subject-specific ones.
3. Student-Teacher Interaction:
  - 3.1. Teachers should be more approachable and cater to doubts.
  - 3.2. Strengthen communication between teachers and students.
  - 3.3. Build a friendly yet disciplined rapport between teachers and students.
4. Feedback & Improvement:

5. Specific College Feedback:

  - 5.3. Highlight the importance of activities like debates, dances, etc., for holistic development.
6. Miscellaneous Suggestions:
  - 6.1. Ensure transportation facilities, especially bus services.
  - 6.2. Emphasize the availability of books and practical resources.
  - 6.3. Highlight the importance of cleanliness and infrastructure.
