What a priceless blessing we enjoy to be involved in kingdom business until our Lord returns!



accomplished through us this year:

- We were able to print our <u>Face to Face</u> booklet in Haitian Creole and had them distributed in Haiti through a supporting church in Sarasota, Florida
- We are now working on having our booklets translated into Portuguese for Brazil.
- In November, we were able to put together 700 care bags with school supplies, hygienic items, food and clothing for children and seniors in Jamaica. It was an awesome opportunity to touch the lives of those who may not have received help other than through you.
- Another amazing work God is doing is in the lives of students in St. Lucia. Attached is a report from Casilda Severin and Josephine Albert, our faithful and diligent workers in that island.

But there is still much work to be done, and again we ask for your help. Here's how:

◆ Jamaica urgently needs 50,000 copies of <u>The Backyard Club</u> for distribution to the elementary school kids as of this January 2019. The Ministry of Education has already given its approval for this project in the island's schools. The cost of printing the booklets is \$11,328 USD. It is our prayer that we will begin to see an increase in the number of Souls added to His Kingdom at the various schools across the island of St. Lucia.



It will be a great joy to return. The students in this school asked lots of questions about theaven and hell. I also returned on another occasion to bring gifts to the children and a small token for one Teacher.

The Assistant Director of Probation indicated that she will be gathering a group of Juveniles for me to conduct the No Worries group sessions at the department's conference room.
