Members of the Omaha Magical Society consistently recognize that their involvement with the art of magic enriches their lives. That passion in turn motivates the club to share that joy with others. Having provided on-site magic classes for children and youth for ten years, the natural progression seemed to take classes now to underserved students (grades 4-7) in the Omaha area.



Progression

Designing The Magic That Matures™ twelve-week curriculum, field testing the classes and the accompanying online videos took two and a half years. We are now in the stage of selecting and training the teachers as well as identifying the sponsoring organizations. The business model will enable the club to pay the teachers of the classes.



Curriculum

Containing 27 different magic tricks the curriculum segments into three four-week phases with a different colored cup being awarded to a student upon successful completion of the tricks in each phase until each student owns their own set of the classic Cups and Balls.
