On May 30, 1976, the Sheldon Bicentennial Committee dedicated a memorial boulder with a plaque listing Revolutionary War soldiers who lived in the Town of Sheldon. New historical research has identified several additional Sheldon patriots who were previously unknown.

As part of Sheldon's America 250 observance, and in honor of their service and sacrifice, a new monument bearing their names will be unveiled and dedicated on May 30, 2026, at the Sheldon Historical Society Schoolhouse Museum—50 years to the day after the original dedication. Also featured will be two Patriot Burial markers to be dedicated and installed at Sheldon's pioneer cemeteries. This ceremony will be a meaningful and lasting tribute to the thirty-one Revolutionary War Patriots who once called Sheldon home.
