Supervisor May called the board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall located at 3529 Rt. 20A, Warsaw, New York.

Supervisor May opened with the Pledge of Allegiance; all were thanked for attending the meeting. [There were no questions or comments from the audience.]

Supervisor May discussed that the county, Mr. Scott Schrader is looking into purchasing Wyomoco for a county park. The board discussed this and are not on board with this purchase as a county park.

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the February 12, 2026 meeting minutes. On a motion by Mr. Ahl, seconded by Mr. Herman to approve the minutes. [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl Noes: [0] Carried

Zoning Report: We had one land separation completed.

Highway Superintendent Report:

- 2/14/2026-2/20/2026 Mainly plowing and sanding. Pushed back for water, mixed a little sand and salt, and changed 208 cutting edges.
- 2/21/2026-2/27/2026 Plowed and sanded, 21st freezing drizzle all day, worked in shop, and patched some holes. Picked up 203 On the 23rd drove home and took right back still was not right, they had to readjust shift linkage. Delacey informed me if the shift issue continues to happen, we will have to remove transmission and fix the internal park prawl.
- 2/28/2026- 3/6/2026 Shop work, plowing, and 3/5 freezing rain all night.
- 3/7/2026-3/12/2026 Worked in shop, fixed some washouts, and cleaned up some debris from high winds.
- Switch to 10 hour days 3/30/2026.

Supervisor May requested a motion to switch to summer 10 (ten) hour days. On a motion by Mr. Ahl, seconded by Mr. Boxler to return to summer hours as of 3/30/2026. [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl Noes: [0] Carried

- Need to replace roof over board room. There was a leak in the judge's room, had water and ice build up and it leaked down the wall, the paint is bubbling.
- Requesting approval to replace #1 pickup, Van Bortal is \$65,000 with 9 ½ foot plow. Ford ready in 90-120 days and Chevy 120 – 150 days. \$34,00 trade in. On a motion by Mr. Ahl, seconded by Mr. Herman to purchase the Ford truck. [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl Noes: [0] Carried

- Grader needs some pretty big repairs, worth 10k- 15k needs thousands in repairs. Found Town of Thurston is auctioning off their grader. Would like to discuss the possibility of possibly purchasing. March 17 the auction is over, \$48,000 - \$50,000. The authorized to bid up to \$50,000. [Place a bid \$43,500 on the auction site but after closes \$50,000. - Sign 284 agreement. On a motion by Mr. Ahl, seconded by Mr. Boxler to spend Town Highway Funds. [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl Noes: [0] Carried
- Talk about water in the new building.

Town Clerk Report: The Towns total revenue for the month of March 2026 \$345.00, \$100.00 for Zoning, \$180.00 for dog licenses, \$40 for marriage license, \$25.00 for late fees. We had 19 renewal licenses. To the general fund, \$201.50, Zoning -\$100.00, Dogs were \$59.00, \$25.00 for late fee and \$17.50 for marriage license. We disbursed \$100.00 to Wyoming County, and \$21.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs and \$22.50 to NYDSOH.

Supervisor May requested a motion to amend abstract #2. On a motion by Mr., Herman, seconded by Mr. Boxler to amend abstract #2. [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl Noes: [0] Carried

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the 2026 Highway Fund Bills: Abstract #3 Vouchers #33 through #51 totaling \$65,105.82. A motion was made by Mr. Boxler, seconded by Mr. Herman to approve the payment of the Highway Fund bills. [4] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl Noes: [0] Carried
