Supervisor May explained to the Board that the Court Grant funding has been approved, \$1,600.00 toward the ADE.

We have received a letter of notice from attorney Kurtzhalts, regarding the litigation matter. The petitioner will drop their 2024 / 2025 petition and no refunds will be paid. For the 2024 – 2026 tax year the assessment of the petitioner's property will be set at \$950,000.00 and will remain at that figure for 3 additional years (per RPTL 727) regardless of revaluation. It would change only if there was a physical change to the property.

Zoning Report: There was no Zoning permits issued.

<u>Highway Superintendent Report:</u>

We have plowed and sanded a couple of times since last month. Cleaned up from pushing banks back with loader. Started to broom on Buffalo and Standish roads. Have been working in shop and on trucks, skid paver and miscellaneous. Cleaned up a few trees from high winds last week. We have hauled in some 1" and 2" crusher run for upcoming road work. I did order 1000 ton of chipping stone before the price went up in April. Currently we are cutting trees and brush on Hollow Road. 205 is at Hawk Frame and Axle waiting. I spoke to Jeff in the frame shop and he figured our truck would be in the shop first of next week. Our men hung the heaters in the new building. Jared Beach has the electrical wrapped up for the most part. Reisdorf is going to hook up the propane. Electrical inspector went through the inspection of new building, his only corrections he required were shut off switches for all three over head doors, and a shut off for the big exhaust fan. Corrections have been made, I just need to contact the inspector to come back for a final.

Need to renew shared agreement with the state. The state is going to begin doing deep area milling with a two foot mill in the next month or two. Asking for the boards approval to go to highway school June 2-4, 2025.
