- 10/7/-10/8 Helped village of Attica Pave
- 10/9-10/10 worked with the county putting shoulders on for them, then for us (Buffalo, Gassman, Syler and Dunham)
- 10/14-10/17 Mowed road sides and made the grates for cold storage, cleaned up 206 for auction.
- 10/21-10/24 finished up mowing, cold patched, patched dirt roads, finished up installation of oil and water separator for cold storage.
- 10/2-10/31 ditched centerline road
- 11/1-11/7 ditched and worked on trucks for inspection as well as getting ready for winter
- 10/14/2024 county took 208 to fine star in Rochester had a code, ended up being the dosing injector.
- 206 bids closed at \$28,500 need to accept or deny
- Talk about storage space
- Bid mechanicals
- Prices #1
- Talk about space out back – would like to cut down about 40 small pines and go 100feet back – board ok with taking out trees and leveling up land.
- Gutters cold storage
- Tires 205 & 207
- – moving dirt – water line by cold storage was 10 feet deep, put a culvert over for access

- Water separator in – Tyvek starting to go up
- Ordered the steel
- Will put up gutters on the building so guys do not get wet going in and out of building. Will get three quotes

Town Clerk Report: The Towns total revenue for the month of October 2024 was \$961.00, \$774.00 for dog licenses, \$37.00 for DEC, \$60.00 for registrar and \$90.00 in late fees and enumeration fees. To the general fund, \$394.04, \$242.00- dogs, \$90.00 for late fees and enumeration fees, DEC-\$2.0, \$60.00 for Registrar. To Wyoming County \$430.00, Ag and Markets \$102.00, to DEC-\$34.96. (withdraw)

We have licensed 39 new dogs during the enumeration and renewals of 31 dogs. We sent out 565 cards – we have gotten a return of 295 (52%) we licensed 118 new dogs.

Ms. Perez stated that the Varysburg Fire District has been added to the budget. Supervisor May asked for motion to close the public hearing on the 2025 budget. On a motion by Mr. Flint, seconded by Mr. Boxler to close the public
