

Exciting worship experiences, spirit-filled meetings, meaningful workshops, delicious meals at a gathering of 400+ pastors, delegates, visitors at the Penn Stater Hotel and Conference Center and I had the privilege of representing First UCC as a delegate at the first PA UCC Spring meeting June 7-9. The purpose was for the 4 Pennsylvania Conferences (Penn West, Pennsylvania Southeast, Penn Central and Penn Northeast where First UCC is a member) to be together as one and to learn what the pastors and delegated will be voting on November 9, 2024. Voting will decide on whether to merge the four conferences into becoming the Keystone Conference in the United Church of Christ, In January 2022, the Conference Ministers of the 4 PA Conferences began gathering statistics, holding informational and feedback workshops through the region to discern God's call for the future. Reading and discussing the 67 pages at the meeting about the possible merger, declining memberships, and churches closing there has been an awareness that something has to change. TOGETHER WE ARE STRONGER is the theme and throughout our time together it was indeed good to have the four conferences assembled to begin the exciting possibility of becoming the Keystone Conference in the United Church of Christ in Pennsylvania and represent First UCC as delegate at the vote in November. 


