





Highlights of Treasure's April Report

Our YTD (Year to Date) cashflow is down \$1,139.

We have used 36% of our budgeted Annual Expenses for the year.

Our investments are up 5% for the year.

Our utility bills increased by 30.6% over the same period in 2022.
