#### **Treasurer's Report** – Tammie Vosburg

Report accepted as submitted.

Highlights:

- We are not meeting our annual budget by \$13,842 so far. Summer months have always shown less giving.
- Our investments did very well this month.
- Wimmer Fund has covered several capital projects this year

#### Pastor's Report: Pastor Becky

Highlights:

Hours Dedicated to Worship: 33, Hours Dedicated to Pastoral Care: 6, Continuing Education Hours: 6, Office Hours: 25, Meetings: 9, VBS: 23

Other

- I was home with COVID on 7/14. Marji led worship, and Diane French read my sermon.
- I assisted with VBS.
- Vacation 8/25-8/31, Susan Lishman preaching on 8/25.
- I was accepted into the Doctorate of Ministry program at Lancaster Theological Seminary. Classes begin 9/16. I will be in Lancaster for an intensive from 10/7-10/11.

#### Faith Formation Report: Marji Hughes

- Faith Formation met on July 15. We put together all VBS loose ends and talked about the beginning of the Sunday School program year. Our next meeting is on August 19.
- The open-table communion informational letter for the whole congregation went out on August 6.
- Following worship on Sunday, September 8, there will be an information session and Fellowship Hour for all.
- Soaking Up God is our theme for Kick Off Sunday on September 8.
- October 5 10 am All are welcome to come and bake bread for World Communion Sunday.
- October 6 is World Communion Sunday and Family Sunday, followed by Fellowship Hour
- Grief Share will begin September 10, led by the Teitsworths.
- Lower Saucon UCC has been offered the first UCC day at Iron Pigs on September 22, as we have fewer than half the sign-ups we need.
- Instead of Youth Group this fall, Pastor Becky and I have decided to try a couple of friendly activities, such as Mini-Golf or an Escape Room. As details are completed, there will be announcements and sign-ups.
- The Women's Retreat is November 15-17.

Additional Discussion: A revision to the June motion to address curriculum suggestions is proposed after Pastor Becky met with staff and Bible Study members.
