

I am writing this sitting out on the porch at my grandfather's house, staring out on the fields that I used to run barefoot through as a child. Thirty years ago feels like yesterday right now. That little bird felt like a reminder. We worry about so many things. We are almost constantly moving. There is always something or someone calling for our attention. The anxieties of this life and this world can often feel overwhelming. In the middle of all of it, I pray that you realize that you are valuable, that you are loved. I hope you are taking time to pause for wonder. The beauty of nature and of other people can remind us of the love that God has for us and for creation. Days like this are the ones where I wish I could just pause time and sit with God for a long while. As we enjoy the last bit of summer, may you be overwhelmed only by the beauty of the world and people around you.

Classes for pre-k through grade 1, and Grades 2-6 begin following the Children's Message.


Each Sunday, children begin in worship at 10:30am and are invited to class following the Children's Message.








NEW BETHANY HOSPITALITY CENTER BETHLEHEM

Bethlehem Emergency Sheltering, Inc. (BES) operates an emergency shelter which is open every night, November 15th to April 30th.

BES policies and procedures have been created to be in accordance with city, county, state, and federal regulations. Shelter rules have been implemented for the safety of their guests, staff, volunteers, and visiting service providers. Dinner is provided ever night and showers are available.

Free bagged lunches are provided every Saturday and Sunday from 11:45 AM—1:00 pm to anyone needing a lunch that day.

September Hoagie Fundraiser




Hoagies will be made by Gerrity (Valley Farm Market)

We will be again selling Nutrolls as a fundraiser. More information will be available in upcoming Newsletters. Pick-up will be in November, before Thanksgiving.



Treasurer's Report – Tammie Vosburg, report Accepted

Highlights: Church is doing well. Deficit of \$1313

• More information is needed to understand what is covered by the yearly cost of \$1290 yearly contract with E.F. Laudenslager. Is this a new line item we want to add to the budget? \$800 was specifically received for the AC repairs.

- Keith's appeal to the congregation for donations for special projects has been effective and yielded positive results. VBS has received donations from parents of children who are attending VBS.
- Congregation donations are up.
- Motion to move ER funds (\$1900) back to a savings type account to yield interest and close ER bank account.

Highlights: VBS was a great week. Thanks to Marji Hughes and all our volunteers.

Discussion: Amy Mixa suggested consideration to hold VBS during evening hours versus the traditional 9-12 due to parents working during the day. There will be a survey sent out to the volunteers via text / email to gather thoughts on potential to change VBS hours. Additionally, consider dates that don't coincide with Bethlehem Musikfest as this may have had a negative impact on attendance. (32 First UCC, 25 Lower Saucon UCC)

- Hellertown Community Day will be taking collections for flood victims during the selling of popcorn.

Committee Reports: Kitchen committee has 10 people signed up with 2 teams for upcoming events. Annual report shall define job descriptions for workers..

Executive Meeting: Doug Major, Pastor Becky met 8-7-25 to plan today's meeting.

Music and Worship: Keith Lentz Next meeting 9/8/25.

Safety and Security: N/A

Stewardship/ Fundraising: Ashlynn Mixa, Next Meeting 9/14/25, 11:00am.

Only 3 people signed up for Community Day. Popcorn for sale or donation for flood victims. Doug will provide 10 cases of water as donation for First UCC Popcorn Booth.

Altar: Pastor Becky will meet with the Altar Committee to discuss Parament schedule.

Tech Committee: Thanks to James Rosenberger for his expertise and work in updating the video and audio platforms for VBS. It worked very well. Still more updates to the entirety of the system to be done. This is a process over time and James Rosenberger will continue to make suggestions to make this system more reliable and easier to operate / train people to operate. Pastor Becky expressed her desire to have 2 projectors and 2 screens on either side of the altar (removing main centered screen) to project lyrics, announcements and scripture readings etc... during service.
