

Seating options

No stooping

Armrests are designed to hang catheter bags and drains on

The IV pole & bracket

It is directly attached to the patient's chair, facilitating easier patient care and monitoring

Optional shoulder wings

No need for a spring; simply lift and swing them out of the way. They have 3 positions: closed, splayed, and open
