The Postal Administration of Hyderabad (Deccan) had prepared perfins in the year 1909 on the ½ Anna (Brick Red) 1871-1909 for the use of Government offices only. "SAKARI" in Persian script was perforated into these stamps.

Perforated 'Sarkari' Stamps

It was in this context of experimentation vide clause 4 of the Minister's order cited that prior to the reissue of the official stamps in 1909, the postal Administration of Hyderabad envisaged the idea of introducing official stamps with perforated "SARKARI" instead of overprinting on a trial basis, perhaps, to save the recurring expenditure of the overprinting ink. The illustration shows a marginal block of twenty of ½ anna stamps (brick-red) of the third series of 1871-1909 (the then current stamp), prepared for issue for official use, with the word "SARKARI" meaning 'official' or 'Service' perforated on each stamp. These perforations were done locally at the Mint. Each stamp of the sheet is perforated with the word 'Sarkari' in Persian script. A sheet consisted of 240 stamps in sixteen horizontal rows of fifteen stamps. The perforations are also found in the upper horizontal margin of the sheet indicating that the stamps were perforated by machine. The perforations are regular and flawless. The Persian script of the word SARKARI is also perfect in every respect and suggests that it was designed by a mature calligrapher. These were tried but did not meet the approval of the Postmasters because while separating the stamps from the sheet, the stamps got damaged (due to tear), since the perforations in the middle weakened the paper. Even if stamps had been perforated sideways along the vertical side (vertical side is longer than the horizontal side) the problem still remained as this also would not prevent the stamps from getting damaged while separating. So the then current stamps overprinted with old dies were issued again.

There are two major problems to be solved. First, when were they issued and second, who was the calligrapher. Perhaps, these may not at all be capable of solution at this late date. However, it was reliably learnt from a senior retired official of the Hyderabad Postal Department that QUDRATULLAH KHAN, a noted calligrapher and engraver who prepared dies for the first ½ anna stamp issued in 1902 (S.G. No. 21) was also the master calligrapher for the perforated SARKARI stamps. Thus, in the absence of official documents, it still remains to be established.

PERFORATED SERVICE

WITH the incorporation of the state of Hyderabad into the Indian Union, there has been a mounting interest in the obsolete stamps of the state. The increased demand has resulted in the unearthing of some strange varieties, one of which is a sheet of the half anna brick-red issued for official use.

The word "Sarkari," meaning "Official" or "Service," is perforated on every stamp. These perforations are also to be seen on the upper border of the sheet which suggests that the entire sheet was perforated on machine. The perforations are regular and flawless. The Persian script of the word "Sarkari" is also perfect in every respect and suggests that it was designed by a nature calligrapher.

It may be recalled that the Official stamps with overprints "Sarkari" were first issued in 1873 but discontinued in 1878 and Government letters were sent without stamps. It was sufficient to write the word "Sarkari" on the top of the cover and the name of the sending office below.

The Government again decided in 1909 to issue official stamps as certain Jagirdars and Paigah officers (Small Feudatory States) took undue advantage and sent their letters without stamps by writing the word "Sarkari" on the covers and it became difficult for the Post Offices to distinguish them from the Government letters.

From the information which I could gather it appears that prior to the re-issue of official stamps with "Sarkari" overprints in 1909 the stamps Department of the Government of Hyderabad tried perforated "Sarkari." These were withdrawn soon after as complaints were received from the Postmasters that when separating the stamps from the sheets they were damaged as the paper loses its strength due to perforation in the middle and stamps overprinted with old dies were issued again.

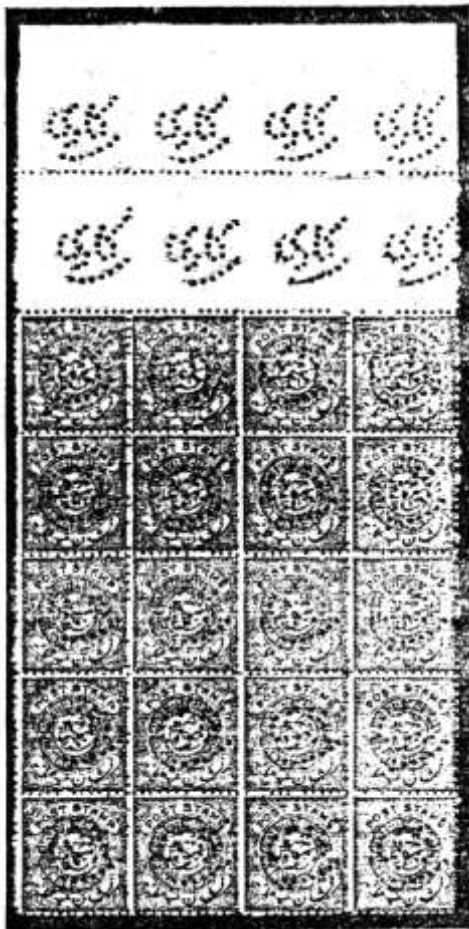

INDIA DIES USED IN BURMA PRE 1948 (INDIA CAT N^{OS})

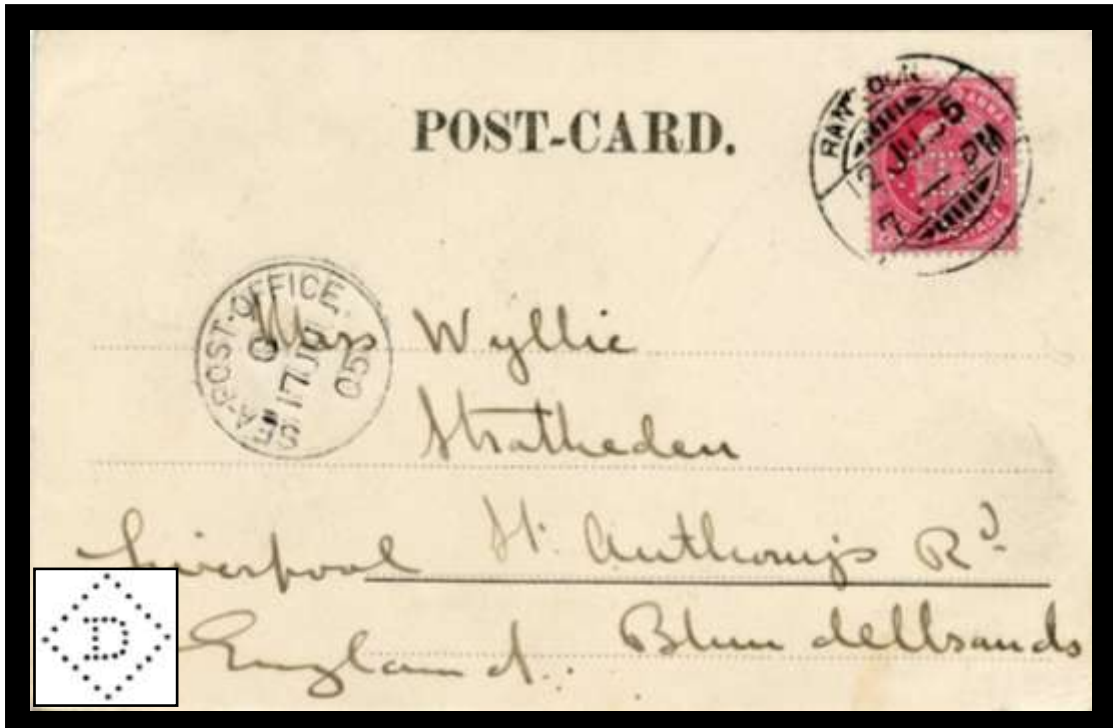
