## MORE ON LLOYD TRIESTINO

The article in the May Bulletin concerning a Lloyd Triestino Perfin cover from Egypt, brings a note from Jack Brandt that he has a similar Lloyd Triestino cover. The ship, however, is "PFO Pilsna." Jack reports that he did some further checking and found mention of these cancels in <u>Ocean Mails</u>, by Philip Cockrill, where the "PFO" is confirmed as standing for "Steamship." The book notes that it is also sometimes abbreviated "Pirosc," and, on newer cancels, is "Motonave" for motor-driven ships. Cockrill mentions the ship "Helouan," covered in the May article, but not the "Pilsna." However, his listing apparently does not purport to be complete.
