As far as I know, you can only see the difference if you have a postmark where you read the origin.

Jack Brandt asks for more countries with number Perfins. Enclosed are copies of what I have, which are from Sweden, England, Fiji, Hong Kong, Jamaica and South Africa. These are not Perfins, as Jack also knows (editor's note: Brandt's comments appeared in the July/August 1976 <u>Bulletin</u>, in which he pointed out that the numeral Perfins were from address labels attached to films sent in for

processing).
