THE EXCHANGE PACKET

It has been suggested that members should make up their own books and that these should be circulated by me to interested members, the Group charging a commission of 10%. This I am willing to do and propose the following procedure.

Selling Members: make up books (not exceeding 7"x4%" in size) of individually mounted perfins with perfin written underneath and the price above. It is, of course, pointless to include common perfins on common stamps since all members will have more than enough without buying more. Tentatively I suggest these books should be confined to,

- a/ perfins on Q.V. or K.E. VII stamps.
- b/ perfins on high values (2/6d or over)
- c/ perfins on commemorative issues.
- d/ modern perfins on low value stamps if there is reason to believe that the perfins are rare.

The books should be sent to me and I will do the rest.

Buying Members: first of all lot me know you want to participate.

Books will be sent as and when available. They should be returned within 7 days with remittance for perfin bought, plus postage to you. (We have to charge this in case you only buy a few, when 10% would mean a loss to the Group. If you spend 5/- or more; the E.P. will stand the postage to you.

I should like to remind those members who do not take part that the normal exchange packets are run on approval lines and consist of some hundreds of individually mounted perfins. The perfin is written under each stamp and prices vary from one fifth of a penny each to a maximum of 1d each for K.G.V. and later issues, and 2d each for earlier issues.
