Since the founding of the NCR many branches have been opened all around the world and today there are 1100 offices in 120 countries.

One of the oldest European brancheswas in Paris. It was registered under the name of La National Caisse Enregistreuse, S. A. and hence the Perfin bears the letters "NCE." I only have a cover, but no loose copy to reproduce the Perfin. Data are: h 9½ mm. Holes N2O - C9 - E12.

In Great Britain, NCR has an office in London and the following five types of Perfins are known:
