

A checklist of perfins on Scott 332 & 375, continued

Last month we brought you the first installment of this checklist. It continues here. But before we continue the checklist, we thought you might like to know a little more about Larry Owen, the member who compiled the list.

Larry started studying the violin when he was 9 (he was born in Trenton, MI, in 1919), and he planned to be a professional musician. But the depression came along and suggested that he follow a more "profitable" career. Since his father had a successful drug store, he got a degree in pharmacology, passed the state board exams, and then joined the Navy as a pharmacist's mate. After the war, he became a teacher and returned to music school. He holds a degree in violin from the Juilliard School of Music and a masters in violin from the University of Michigan. He now teaches strings and plays professionally in Dallas, takes special pleasure in playing in a string quartet, and has been an active perfin collector since 1964. He has a good collection of 332/375, but still has many spaces to fill.
