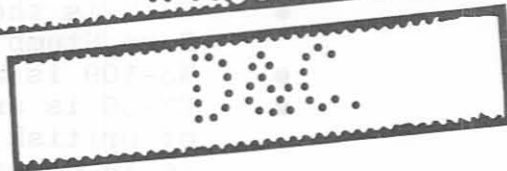
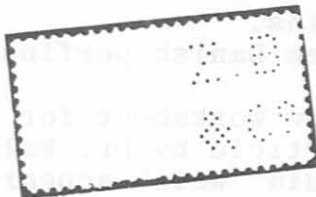
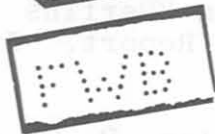
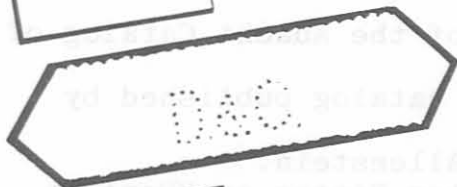


**Revenue

1. B&C
2. D. & C. with small holes
3. D. & C.
4. D&C. Large & with no period after the D. A D&C is known on postage stamps, used by Dannemann & Cia. of Sao Felix and Bahia
5. FWB
6. Z.B/& Co. is also known on postage stamps, used by Zerrehmer Bulow & Cia. of Sao Paulo.
