PUCTURED ENDORSEMENTS ON THE SURFACE-PRINTED ISSUES

Whereas the number of dies on the Line-Engraved issues is abundant, those on the surface printed are comparitively few. This is largely because of the higher values involved for which there was less postal requirement. The surface- printed puntures were used mainly for the transmission of sums of money of a small amount through the post (hence the existance of quite a number of mint examples which were probably overlooked and not cashed); or on mail posted to overseas destinations; or on letters registered and/or expressed.

It will almost invariably be found that the highest values, 2/- upwards, were used by bankers. The most prolific of these is the Hong Kong & Shanghai Bank (H S B) who undoubtedly required these for large packets of documents etc., transmitted to the Far East. Another user quite frequently found is Charles J. Hambro and Sons (C.I.H/S) the London bankers.

Quite a lot of the surface printed punctures are found with Foreign Branch cancellations and also with Newspaper Branch obliterations. Further testimony that many of these stamps were used in the publishing and printing trade (usually below the 1/- value) is to be found in the fact that so many stamps bear the private cancellations of, Smith, Elder & Co., (subsequently H.S. King & Co.,), W.H. Smith & Son, and William Dawson & Son. The stamps bearing these obliterations usually also have the punctured initials of the firms using them.

Many firms who used line-engraved punctures quite extravagantly are completely missing in the lists of surface-printed, showing that their business did not necessitate the use of higher values in sufficient quantities to require puncture protection. On the other hand some firms are found to have used punctured surface printed whose dies have not been found on line-engraved.

The lists on the following pages are compiled from stamps in my own collection plus some reported by Mr. Rymer-Young and others. The list must be far from complete as many members have not sent lists of their own examples, but I shall still be happy to receive additions and corrections for future revision.

This present listing comprises over 250 different dies.
