Evidence for progressive pin loss - *single headed* die.

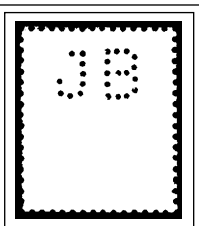

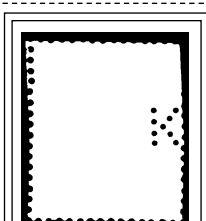


Note 3-bar duplex in use in Nottingham from mid 1880's to 1895.

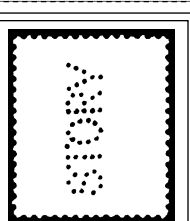

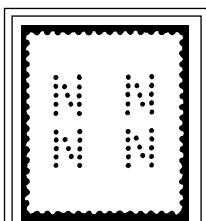

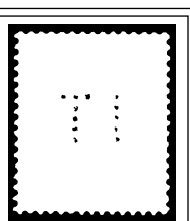
