Between 1931-38 Commonwealth issues with the perfin W over A were brought into use and continue to be used-by, State Departments. The perfin is usually found upright but on horizontal stamps it is sideways, reading either way.

Double perfins are known, and also pairs where one stamp is normal and the other has the perfin.
