HELP WANTED

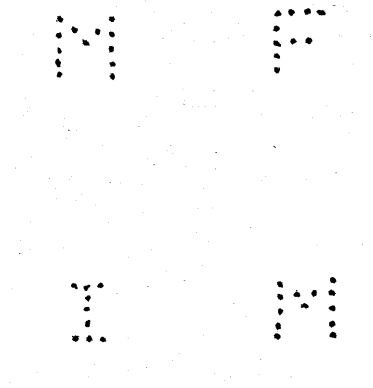

COMMEMORATIVE PERFINS

FILATELICO INTERNAZIONALE MILANO



This item, obviously an Italian Philatelic Commemorative Perfin, has been reported by Mr C. Carr.

The perfin is on a block of four stamps of the Italian 1945 issue - the 40c. grey, "Planting a Tree". The stamps are on a numbered card, and on the card is the wording:

FILATELICA INTERNAZIONALE

MILANO

16 GENNAIO - 14 FEBBRAIO

1946
