

"C" PERFIN'S OF CARTERS' TESTED SEEDS LTD

The reduced sized photocopy on the next page, is of a cover sent in by BILL HANSON. I agree with Bill that it shows some interesting points. The envelope is 9x6½ins and was not sealed by the usual methods. It has 3 eyelet holes through flap & envelope which were probably fastened by folding studs.

The customs label gives the information that the envelope contained Vegetable Seeds bound for New Zealand. There was a Certificate Of Health enclosed, according to the typing on the top of the envelope.

The seeds were posted 2nd Class on 24-5-57 and the purple cachet tells us that on 31-5-75 it had "PASSED AT WELLINGTON, THE N.Z. DEPT OF AGRICULTURE PLANT QUARANTINE". Today, even 1st Class post would do well to reach N.Z. so quickly.
