
# Lynchburg Shoe Co. - L141

The return envelope with courtesy stamp punched with the LS/Co of perfin pattern L141, illustrared on page 163, is an identifying cover. The LS/Co fits the Lynchburg Shoe Co. nicely. Unfortunately, this cover did not pass through the mail and therefore there is no

postmark tieing the stamp to the cover. On the other hand, notice the apparent cutter bar perforations at the top of the stamp. That is an indication of an early private coil.
