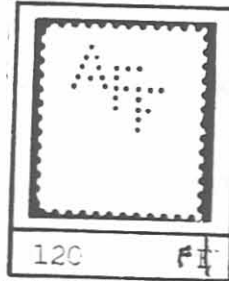

We now have a more complete name for the company, Acme Fast Freight, Inc. and know that the company also operated an office out of 130 Clinton Street, Brooklyn, NY in 1947. This office is in addition to the Boston, MA address listed in *The Catalog of United States Perfins*.

the perfin pattern was used by Acme Tea & Storage Company, Long Island City, NY; Atlas freight, Inc., San Francisco, CA. In addition, postmarks from Philadelphia, PA; Atlanta, GA; and Milwaukee, WI have been found on stamps with this perfin pattern.
