An interesting cover, submitted by Jim Estes (#2649) is shown on page 16. The corner card is from the Pontiac Motor Division of General Motors Corporation in Pontiac, MI. The addressee is Divisional Comptroller, Pontiac Motor Division, General Motors Corporation in Pontiac, MI.

The 3 cent Jefferson stamp is not perfined, but

the two 1 cent Washington stamps that were applied to make up the airmail rate are perfined with perfin pattern "ACB", A58. However, the postmark is SAN FRANCISCO/SEPT 16/7PM/1947/LINCON??

Is this the positive identification cover. I do not think that it qualifies. Barring an other confirming cover, I think that we will have to leave A58's user unidentified in *The Catalog of United States Perfins* for a while.
