
Knoxville Railway & Light Company - K56

Here is the identification of the real user of perfin pattern K56. *The Catalog of United States Perfins*, Balough & Balough, 1979, lists the user as "Knoxville Ray & Light Co." on page 239. While the catalog used a large number of abbreviations to save space, "Ray" was not one of the abbreviations. The correct abbreviation for railway was "Rwy".

We now know that the company's correct name is "Knoxville Railway & Light Company" of Knoxville, Tennessee. It appears that the local electric power company also operated the electric trolleys.
