Previously unidentified in *The Catalog of United States Perfins*, 1979, this stock confirmation slip (shown on the on page 30) from Wertheim & Company has four revenue stamps punched with pattern W/&Co (B210.5). The slip not only tells us that the user was Wertheim & Company of 120 Broadway, New York, NY, but also that the company was a Stock Brokerage.

Also of interest a rubber stamp "FAILURE" leaves me puzzled as to its meaning. I also note that they were members of the "New York Curb Exchange" which has become the American Stock Exchange.
